## 3 Ways to Earn Extra Money & Get Free Stuff

We like to periodically share some ways that you can earn some extra income or get free stuff. Today iMoneyCoach is offering 3 ideas that may not earn you big money but can produce some good rewards for a little bit of time:

**1. Publish eBooks** – iMoneyCoach has recently started using a new eBook publishing system, and we wanted to share it with those of you who like to write or read. [Smashwords](#) is a great way to turn your print books into eBooks so they can reach a wider variety of people. There are no upfront fees either, making it a safer investment (they are more motivated to help you sell your books because they don't get anything until you sell). And if you like to read, there are many reasonably priced, and even FREE, books available for download on your computer, iPad, iPod, Kindle, etc.

**2. Mystery Shopping** – While not a great way to earn a lot of money, mystery shopping can be a fun way to earn goodies like new clothes, free meals, or free haircuts. The [Mystery Shopping Providers Association](#) offers a search form where you can see all the mystery shops available in your area. Usually mystery shopping requires you to pay for items or services up front and then be reimbursed after you complete a survey about your experience, so you want to be careful about how much you spend and how it

affects your budget. But getting to take the family bowling for free or getting reimbursed for pizza delivery can be a fun experience. (Read [info from the FTC](#) about mystery shopping scams to make sure you get started with the right company – NEVER pay a fee up front to become a mystery shopper!)

**3. Share Your 2 Cents** – At sites like [MySurvey.com](#), [MyPoints.com](#), and [Toluna.com](#), you can sign up to take surveys about products and services and get paid for it. Sites typically offer points or dollar amounts for each survey you complete – then when you get enough points you can redeem them for merchandise or gift cards. This can be a great way to plan for Christmas. If you start now, you can save up points and then redeem several gift cards to give as Christmas gifts or to do your shopping. You won't make tons of money doing surveys, but they can be a great way to earn a little extra income in your spare time. Again, avoid participating in anything that charges a fee up front to participate.
