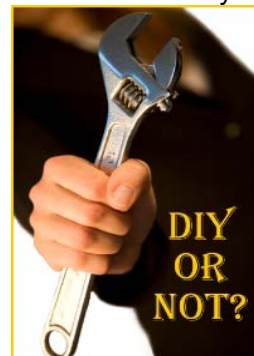
Do it Yourself or Not? When to Call a Contractor

Sometimes when you "do it yourself" you end up spending more time and money on a project than you would by hiring a professional. [Do It Yourself or Not](#) is a website that can help you decide whether to do a project yourself or call a professional.

The site gives you the "do it yourself" and contractor prices and estimated hours for hundreds of home improvement projects. The next time your sink is leaking you can take a quick peek to see if it would be worth it for you to call in a professional or if it would be better to fix it yourself. (Hint: use the Project Costs tab at the top left of the page to get started).

If you are thinking about painting your kitchen cabinets you can search "paint cabinets" and see a comparison of both the time it would take a pro or yourself and the cost. Would you rather spend \$548 to hire a pro and save 25 hours of work, or would you rather do it yourself for \$110?

While it is a good idea to do a little more research and actually call contractors to see what they would charge, this site gives you a good idea. It also provides step-by-step instructions and How-To videos for a variety of projects.
