What Info is Your Photo Giving Criminals?

Digital photography makes snapping and sharing pictures easy. But is this new technology leading criminals right to your door?

Metadata is information about the photo that is stored in your digital photos, such as what type of camera you use or when the picture was taken. But it can also contain GPS coordinates – some phones with cameras, like the iPhone, automatically geotag their photos.

This GPS info could lead criminals to you, your children, or your home. Imagine taking harmless pictures in your home that have something in the background a thief wants and is able to get to because of the metadata stored in the photo!

But you can remove metadata from your photos!
